

Recycle Project



This quarter, First grade will be learning about Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle as well as reading *The Lorax* by Dr. Seuss. This is part of a unit about conservation and recycling.

For this unit each student will be required to take things from around the home and create something new. It can be art, décor, something useful, etc.! Be creative!

In addition, your child will be asked to write (**with your guidance**) the materials and steps needed to make the project. We will be examining the characteristics of this style of writing in class.

Here are the details:

1. Students must make something new from items they find around their home.
2. They must write a “How-to” paper explaining what they made, the materials they used, and how they made it.
 - a. The paper must be written in paragraph/essay form.
 - b. The paper must include a list of materials used.
 - c. The paper must be written by the student. They may, however, receive help regarding spelling and language.
3. All projects and papers are due on **Thursday, April 12th**.
4. Students will present their projects Thursday – Friday.
